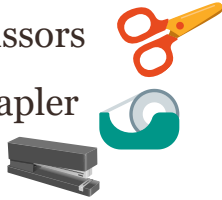
Cause & Effect Chain Reaction Sort

Materials you will need:

- two pages of pre-printed sentence strips
- a pair of scissors
- tape or a stapler



Directions:

1. Cut out each sentence strip.
2. Use the article to help you lay the sentence strips out in order. Look for how one event causes the next event.
3. Take the first sentence strip and tape or staple the ends together to make a loop.
4. Thread the next sentence strip through the first loop and tape or staple the ends together. Repeat until all the strips are connected into a chain .

The Triangle Shirtwaist Factory fire.

Workers strike to protest the cut in the wages.

The workers got their old pay back and better hours.

Factory and mill owners cut the wages of workers due to the Jackson law.

People could not escape the fire; many died.

The State Department of Labor found the reason for the strike was the cut in wages.

The State Department of Labor made a plan to fix the problem.

Jackson Law is passed to help protect workers in part by limiting their working hours.

The State Department of Labor investigates the strike.
