

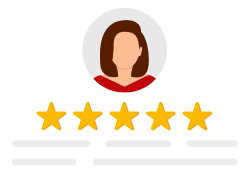
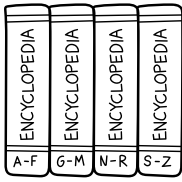

studied.

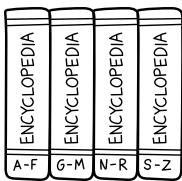
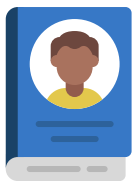


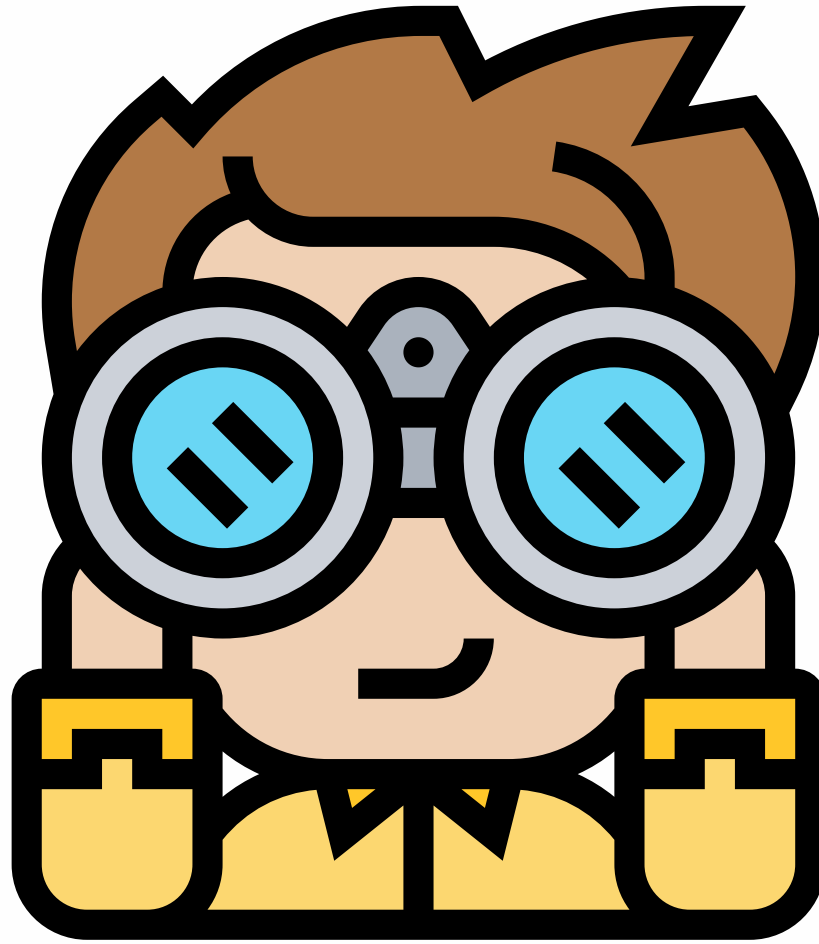

a distance of time or place.

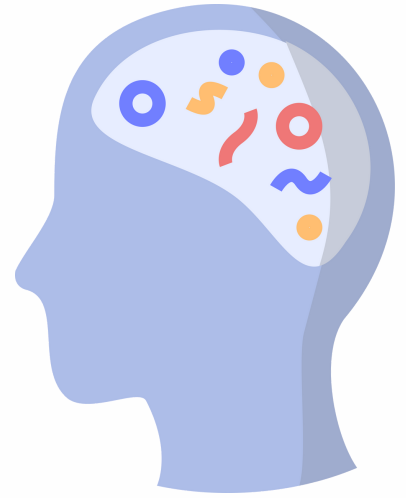
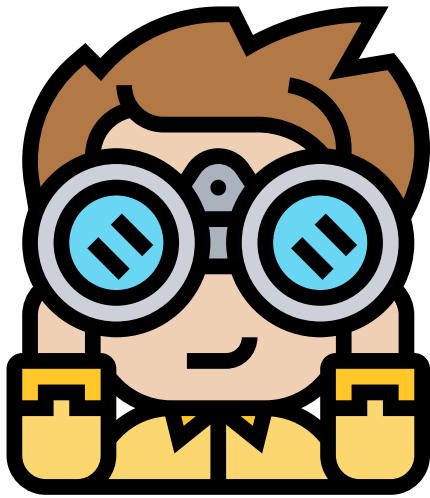




Observation
